3. ACCOMODATION

Shared accommodation in Bermuda will be provided to all competitors at no cost, and food and beverages will be provided to all competitors at significantly reduced costs. We will work towards securing 1 allocated berth for accommodating a parent or guardian, we encourage this as part of the spirit of the event. Additional Legal guardians of competitors will be responsible for arranging and procuring separate accommodation in Bermuda.

The accommodation will be rustic camping dormitory style located near the event village. In order to minimize transport and cost, we have also arranged ferrying to/from the event village. You will not need a car in Bermuda.

Possible requirements:

- Sleeping Bag
- Towel
- Light wet weather gear for warm climates
- Sailing gear Shoes, light bottoms or top.

<u>Items not required:</u>

- Lifejackets they will be provided
- Water bottles provided by the event for participants only
- Caps, Rash-guards will be provided.





4. TRAVEL INFORMATION

How to get here?

• Airlines to Bermuda include Delta, American Airlines, Jet Blue from the USA. Airports include, Atlanta, Boston, Newark, JFK and Miami. From the UK and Europe there is a daily flight with British Airways (London Gatwick). There are also additional flights from Canada based on the time of the season.

How to get to the event village?

• From the airport a Taxi direct to Dockyard (West End). Based on your time of arrival and if there is critical mass we can also assist with a Mini Bus shuttle.

Accommodation -

- Accommodation for RS Feva will be based on **Ports Island** and require a ferry shuttle.
- Accommodation for O'Pen BIC and Hobie Wave are near to Dockyard in **Messina House** and there will be a daily ferry to and from the event village at strict times only.

Other Information:

- Bermuda's climate in June can be very warm 20-30 degrees C. It is suggested that you pack light wear, shorts are recommended, Sun Glasses, Hats, Sun screen. Although very warm it can rain at times and we would advise a very light rain coat or similar.
